Ellsworth Kelly (1923 - 2015)

Ellsworth Kelly was one of the major exponents of post-painterly abstraction in the 1960s, and is known for his influence on Hard-Edge, Colour Field and Minimalist painting. Born in Newburgh, he studied at the Pratt Institute and the Boston School of Museum of Fine Arts. In 1964 he began to make prints with Gemini G.E.L and Tyler Graphics. Printmaking has given him scope for an autonomous activity in which his explorations into composition and surface texture have fed back into his constructions. He lived in New York State until his death in 2015.
