Artist Biography

Ali Kazim (b. 1979)

Ali Kazim was born in Pakistan in 1979. After studying at the National College of Arts in Lahore, he travelled to London to complete an MFA at the Slade School of Art before returning to live and work in Pakistan. While he also works across the mediums of sculpture and installation, Kazim's most prolific work is his portraiture.

Kazim depicts his subjects in intimate moments, rendering each minute detail of their appearance. The quiet meditativeness with which he captures his subjects is reflective of his slow and involved production process; inspired by Bengal School watercolourists, Kazim's method involves building up colour and detail through laying down and washing away pigment, bathing the work in water several times.

Kazim's work has been shown internationally in both solo and group exhibitions, and is held in public collections worldwide.
