### **Artist Biography**

# Marie Harnett (b. 1983)

Marie Harnett's work is inspired by films. She makes small, intricately detailed pencil drawings which capture fleeting moments of drama, suspense or beauty, which are housed in collections around the world. Focusing on every aspect of pose, light and texture, Harnett uses her source imagery to create a unique image that takes on its own life and a new story. Her prints of the same subject matter include large scale linocut prints, which can take up to one month to carve, and an early series of mezzotints, which are housed in the permanent collection at the British Museum, London. Harnett graduated from Edinburgh College of Art in 2006. A year later, in 2007 she was selected for the Contemporary Art Society's ARTfutures, exhibiting in London and at The Aspect Prize at the Paisley Museum. Harnett lives and works in London, England.
