Artist Biography

Paul Winstanley

Paul Winstanley trained at the Slade School of Fine Art, London, from 1976-78, moving on to study further at Cardiff College of Art, Wales. From 1991-1992 he was the Churchill College Cambridge/ Kettles Yard Artist in Residence. Winstanley's typical choice of subject matter - landscapes, deserted passages, lobbies and walkways, empty college TV lounges and anonymous interview rooms - are generally rendered in a muted palette reminiscent of a blurred black-and-white snapshot and they acknowledge the centrality of the photographic image in contemporary life. He currently lives and works in London.
