## **Artist Biography**

## Dexter Dalwood (b. 1960)

Dexter Dalwood was born in Bristol, England in 1960. He studied at Central St. Martins School of Art from 1981 and 1985, and then at the Royal College of Art in London between 1988-89. He had his first solo exhibition in London in 1992. Dalwood's work melds fragments of other artist's work together with found imagery to create provocative and challenging compositions. His paintings and prints stem from intricate small-scale collages which he then re-works into larger pieces. Tate St Ives hosted a major retrospective of his work in 2010, and he was shortlisted for the Turner prize in the same year.
