Artist Biography

Ian Davenport (b. 1966)

Ian Davenport is one of the leading British abstract artists of his generation. He graduated from Goldsmiths College of Art in 1988 and as one of the generation of Young British Artists he participated in the seminal 1988 exhibition *Freeze*. In 1991 he was shortlisted for the Turner Prize and has since exhibited extensively across the world. In 1999 he was a prize winner in the John Moores Exhibition. Davenport has undertaken several large scale site-specific murals, including the 50m long mural under the bridge on Southwark Street, London. In 2016 he collaborated with Dior to produce a limited edition Lady Dior Bag and in 2017 he created 'Wide Acres of Time,' a commission for Swatch Watches. Davenport lives and works in London.
