Idris Khan (b.1978)

Idris Khan was born in Birmingham in 1978; Khan completed his Master's Degree in Fine Art at the Royal College of Art in London in 2004. He has shown internationally, including recent solo shows at the Whitworth Gallery, Manchester; Sadler's Wells, London; Gothenburg Konsthall, Sweden; Museum of Contemporary Canadian Art, Toronto; Kunsthaus Murz, Murzzuschlag, Austria, and K20, Düsseldorf. In 2012, Khan was commissioned by the British Museum in London to create a new wall drawing for the exhibition, Hajj: Journey to the Heart of Islam. In 2014 he collaborated with choreographer Wayne McGregor to produce a stage design for STEPS, Switzerland's contemporary dance biennale. His work is held in numerous public collections across the world. In 2017 Khan was awarded an OBE in the Queen's birthday honours list and won a Culture Summit Abu Dhabi 2017 award for his contributions to cultural diplomacy and promoting positive change.
