Artist Biography

David Hockney (b. 1937)

David Hockney was born in Bradford, England, where he studied art at Bradford School of Art, before he continued on to the Royal College of Art between 1959-1962. Hockney was part of the Young Contemporaries exhibition, alongside for instance Peter Blake, an exhibition that has been credited as the announcement of British Pop Art. Hockney has been associated with pop art, but his early works also suggest a hint of expressionism. In 1967 he won the John Moore's Painting Prize at the Walker Art Gallery in Liverpool. Hockney moved to California in 1964, where he lived for many years, and was inspired to do a series of swimming pool paintings from Los Angeles in bright colours. Hockney has spent time living and working in Paris, London and LA. He now splits his time between Bradford and Los Angeles.
