Richard Serra (b. 1938)

Richard Serra is an American minimalist sculptor and video artist known for working with large-scale assemblies of sheet metal. He was born in San Francisco in 1938. After studying at the University of California, Berkeley and Santa Barbara, he graduated in 1961 with a BA in English literature. During this time, he began working in steel mills in order to support himself. In 1964, he graduated from Yale University with both a BFA and an MFA. Receiving a Yale Travelling Fellowship, he spent a year in Paris, followed by a year in Florence. Although best known for his monumental steel sculptures, Richard Serra is also a prolific and innovative printmaker.
