Artist Biography

Eduardo Chillida (1924 - 2002)

Born in 1924, Eduardo Chillida was one of the most prominent sculptors and print maker of the post-war period. He studied architecture before dropping the subject in favour of drawing and moving to Paris. Chillida created sculptures that explored the spaces between the structures as much as the form themselves. In 1958 he was nominated to represent Spain at the Venice Biennale, where he won the international grand prize for sculpture. His printmaking is an extension of his sculptural practice - It is about process and material as he cuts the etching plates before printing them.

He died at his home near San Sebastián at the age of 78 in 2002.
